## **GRADE / AGE**

GSB camps are generally geared toward students in Kindergarten through grade 8 (as of the 2020/21 school year). For our camps that are available for a large age range of students, activities and roles are differentiated within the group so not all campers are doing the exact same activity. Some camps have specific age requirements.

Please check the individual descriptions. Incoming Kindergarten students for the fall of 2020 are welcome to join the camps open for Kindergarten students.

## **NUMBER of STUDENTS**

The maximum number of students is stated in the camp descriptions. GSB reserves the right to merge camps if there are fewer than 5 students registered in each camp during any given week.

All camps take place at GSB, 17 Eastern Parkway, or the surrounding premises (Prospect Park, Mount Prospect Park, Botanic Garden, and so on).
